# How to find us

## Cygnets Hospital Kewstoke

Beach Road, Weston super Mare

BS22 9UZ



### By car

Exit M5 at J21, for Weston-super-Mare. Take 1st left off dual carriage way to Worle, Sand Bay & Kewstoke. Turn right onto Queen's Way (signs for Kewstoke) & continue over three roundabouts. Entering the village, follow signs to Village Hall (Lower Norton Lane). At T-junction (pink post office opposite) turn right into Crookes Lane, continue until next 1-junction & turn left onto Beach Road. The entrance is on the left past Care Free Holiday Homes.

### By train

Trains run every 20 to 25 minutes from Bristol Temple Meads to Weston-super-Mare. Journey time is approx half an hour.

### By bus

The No.1 runs from Weston-super-Mare Railway Station to Sand Bay. Buses run every hour, with the last bus at 18:08.
