

# Specialist Residential Service for Adults with Learning Disabilities, Autism & Associated Complex Behaviours

## Cherry Tree House, Nottinghamshire

Cherry Tree House is our new specialist residential service providing outcome focussed care for adults with learning disabilities, who may have autism and associated complex behaviours.

Cherry Tree House offers six self-contained apartments, configured to meet the needs of the residents in single occupancy accommodation offering them the next step along their care pathway towards greater independence.

Each apartment has its own bedroom, living and dining space, bathroom and kitchen as well as access to an enclosed communal garden.

Located down a quiet lane, just a 10 minute drive from the bustling town of Mansfield, the individuals supported at Cherry Tree House have access to a large and varied range of community facilities and activities, including cinemas, bowling and local events.

Ongoing assessment and a core staff team means that we are able to meet the changing needs of individuals as they progress through their care pathway, while ensuring their safety is maintained and their independence is supported.

We ensure day-to-day practice is embedded in an overarching framework of support whereby the whole team around the person consciously takes into account the interaction, communication and flexibility of each individual we support.

We provide a comprehensive individually tailored care and support plan that is delivered by the staff team in an integrated, systematic and consistent manner.

- > Adults, aged 18+
- > Primary diagnosis of learning disability accompanied with challenging behaviour
- > May have autism or Asperger's syndrome requiring highly structured and / or modified stimuli environments
- > We do not accept people detained under the Mental Health Act
- > We support individuals on the following sections: 7 (Guardianship), 17 (Planned/ authorised leave), 117 (Aftercare arrangements) and a Community Treatment Order (CTO) or DoLS

## Our referral process:

- 1 Referral made to Cygnet referrals team via **0808 164 4450** / [chcl.referrals@nhs.net](mailto:chcl.referrals@nhs.net) or through your regional Business Relationship Manager

- 3 Feedback provided on whether our service can meet the individual's needs

- 5 Admission agreed and plans for transition arranged with referring team following confirmation of acceptance of placement
